1. Jesus and John: their place

2. Illustration: Sun and moon

3. This conversation in which John the Baptist corrects his disciples.

1. MINISTERS OF GOD ARE NOT IN COMPETITION

1) The case of <u>John and Christ</u> here.

2) The same for Paul: 1 Corinthian 1:12

3) This attitude always does harm:

(i) it is the spirit of the world

(ii) it fails to see that all gifts are of God

(iii) every minister has his own calling

(iv) <u>personal loyalty</u> can be misplaced

<u>APPLICATION</u>: Love and esteem all who preach the word of God – no strife!

2. <u>MINISTERS ARE NOTHING BUT HELPERS OF MEN TO</u> <u>COME TO CHRIST</u>

- 1) <u>John's humility</u>:
 - (i) v.27: Christ's greatest honour
 - (ii) v.28: his disclaimer
 - (iii) v.30: his self-effacement

OBSERVE: The mark of a true minister is that he be deeply humble.

- 2) The unique Glory of Christ: v.29
 - (i) A wedding used as illustration
 - (ii) The Bridegroom is Christ
 - (iii) The Bride = Church

- (iv) The Best Man: only there to help.
- 2) The illustration explained:
 - (i) <u>John</u>, and all ministers, have a past.
 - (ii) <u>But the climax is the Wedding Day.</u>

APPLICATION: O! Look forward to that Day!

3. THERE IS ONE ONLY SUPREMELY IMPORTAND THING IN TRUE RELIGION

- 1) v.33: Faith in Christ as Saviour
 - (i) receiving the <u>truth</u> to our heart
 - (ii) setting our <u>seal</u> to the truth
 - (iii) to do otherwise is to make God a liar
- 2) How we recognise Christ as the Eternal Son of God and Saviour:
 - (i) he "comes from above"
 - (ii) he is "above all"
 - (iii) he speaks of what he has seen
 - (iv) he speaks of <u>heavenly</u> things
 - (v) he is <u>full of the Spirit</u>
 - (vi) he has <u>all authority</u> from God
 See how this fits perfectly the character and ministry of
 Christ: It is <u>all</u> heavenly!
- 3) In the light of all this we must all <u>face up to</u> this challenging fact: v.36.
 - (i) "he that believeth on the Son"
 - (ii) "he that believeth not..."

CONCLUSION

Our place is not to argue with our preachers but to believe in Christ.
