- 3. Especially the balance of Law + Gospel

### 1. THE LAW OF GOD IS MAN'S GREAT PROBLEM

- 1) Which Law do we here refer to: 3 forms
- 2) The Moral Law:
  - (i) the covenant under which we were placed
  - (ii) its demand: to love God and our neighbour
  - (iii) the Ten commandments: Perfection
  - (iv) they depend on the nature of God
- 3) Other forms of Law
  - (i) <u>Ceremonial</u>: the gospel in OT times
  - (ii) <u>Judicial</u>: for the Theocracy
  - (iii) Based largely on the will of God

**APPLICATION**: "Agree with thine adversary"

## 2. TO BECOME DEAD TO THE LAW IS GOD'S SALVATION

- 1) How can man be freed from obligation to God's Moral Law?
- 2) <u>ANSWER</u>: By a <u>change</u> of obligation: ILLUSTRATION: Marriage a second time (Romans 7)
- 3) We only become dead to God's law by entering into a <u>new Covenant</u>
- 4) The gospel-command, or <u>covenant of grace:</u>
  - (i) someone else obeys for us: Christ
  - (ii) someone suffers for us: Christ

- 5) How this comes about: by the Law:
  - (i) Law as Schoolmaster: Romans 7:7-13
  - (ii) Law as Covenant: Romans 7:1-6
- 6) Faith brings us out of covenant with God's Moral Law and into Covenant with Christ.
- 7) Hence our <u>text</u>: a <u>new</u> covenant

**APPLICATION**: It is written on our heart

### 3. THOSE ONLY WHO ARE DEAD TO THE LAW LOVE IT

- 1) The effect is not:
  - (i) The Moral Law is now ignored but rather...
  - (ii) it is fulfilled in our Justification
- 2) Also: because it is on our <u>heart</u>, we love it + keep it: <u>proof</u>
- 3) The Law as our Rule of Life:
  - (i) Paul in Romans 7:14f
  - (ii) James 2:24

**APPLICATION**: This is NT Christianity
