### Introduction

This epistle addresses differences in practices relevant to shallow professions of faith.

Many parts overlap with Sermon on the Mount.

## 1. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PROFESSION AND REALITY (v.14-17)

Profession – If a man <u>say</u>...(14) Professes saving faith, but only has a dead faith that acknowledges the truth to be true and no more.

## 2. <u>SAVING FAITH IS MORE THAN ACKNOWLEDGING THAT</u> <u>THE TRUTH IS TRUE</u> ( V.18-19)

Acts 16:16-17 John 2:21-25 Acts 8: 13, 20-22 Matthew 13:20-21

# 3. ONLY IF OUR FAITH SHOWS IN WORKS ARE WE JUSTIFIED IN REGARDING OURSELVES AS TRUE BELIEVERS (v.20-24)

### 1) Apparent Contradiction

God has not given us a problem-free Bible, though an infallibly true one. (2 Peter 3:16).

### 2) <u>Sense of the use of justification here</u> Grounds on which man concludes a sinner is a true believer. (Hebrews 12:14).
